SAFEGUARDING CHILDREN AND VULNERABLE ADULTS POLICY

Archbishop Mark Coleridge states, "Safeguarding is for Everyone"

As directed by the Archdiocese of Brisbane, we are working with our volunteers to successfully complete our Safeguarding requirements by mid-May. A huge thank you to all those who have already made an effort to complete the process, and to those who are working with us now to finalise their paperwork. All parish Volunteers should have received an email this week detailing necessary steps.

The Archdiocese has just launched an online portal for all volunteers to simplify the process. This portal, titled The Welcome Portal can be found at <https://archbne.org/welcome>.



In a series of simple steps, you enter your details into the portal, including which ministries you volunteer with, and it will pre-populate any forms that you need to sign. You are also able to watch the safeguarding training video online. This should only take around 45 minutes (maybe a little longer depending on which forms you need).

We are also providing an option to watch the training video following each Mass on

the week end of 18/19 May 2019 for those unable to access it online.

If you need help to work through the portal, or have any questions, Veronica and I will be in the office on Thursday morning and available after Masses on 18/19 May to assist. Identification documents may also need to be copied & certified which can also be done in the office on Thursday or next weekend.

If these dates and times are not suitable for you, please contact the parish office or myself to make other arrangements.

We are hoping that by the end of this weekend all forms will be completed and the safeguarding training video will have been viewed by all.

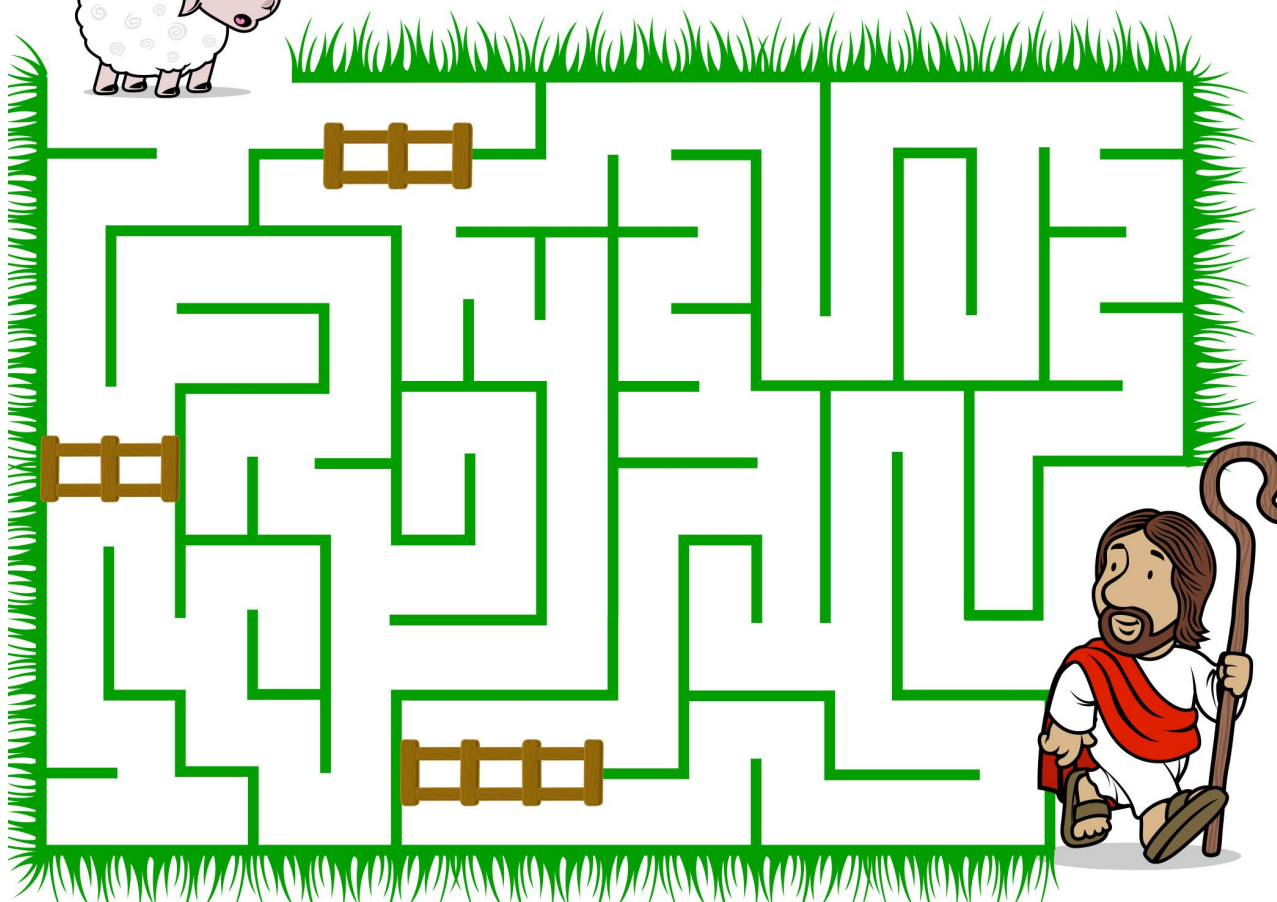
