St Vincent de Paul Christmas Appeal 2019

In February 2019 St Vincent de Paul marked 125 years since the first Conference in Qld was set up at St Brigid's Red Hill.

Our St Thomas' Conference asks that you join with us in offering a hand up to those who are living here in Camp Hill and nearby areas as we launch our annual Christmas Appeal.

As we have done the past two years, we are asking for donations of single store only gift vouchers from KMART, TARGET. BEST AND LESS, WOOLWORTHS AND COLES. *Unfortunately, we cannot accept Coles/Myer or Woolworths group (Wish) Gift cards or the vouchers with Visa or MasterCard as part of them.* The minimum value of the vouchers is \$5 and any amount on them that you can offer is appreciated.

As well as enabling the purchase of fresh food through the Woolworths and Coles vouchers, the Department Store vouchers are used for items such as toasters, electric jugs, small vacuum cleaners. These items aren't available from St Vincent de Paul Stores or our furniture depot due to safety concerns and regulations.

Donations of gift vouchers can be placed in the locked container on the wall at the back of the church or on the collection plate at Mass in a clearly marked envelope.

Donations of cash or cheque for our Christmas Appeal are also very welcome and needed. Tax deductible receipts for \$2 or more are available for the cash and cheque donations but not available for in-kind gifts such as vouchers unfortunately. If you would like a receipt, please include your name and address with the donation.

The Craft for Causes Committee stall has been an annual event of our parish since 2010 and as you know all proceeds go to St Vincent de Paul. Please support it in any way you can as per the committee's own notice.


National Prayer Campaign for Drought
